

TRANSPORT	<p>A comprehensive network of trains, buses and city cats (ferries) link the Brisbane Convention and Exhibition Centre with Brisbane city and suburbs. Translink tickets are the best way to visit and travel around the city. The Translink website contains more details, CLICK HERE to view the website.</p> <p>BUS South Bank is serviced by two bus stations: The Cultural Centre Station on Melbourne Street and the South Bank Busway Station corner of Colchester and Tribune Streets, South Bank. A free city loop bus service circles Brisbane’s Central Business District including South Bank.</p> <p>TRAIN There are two train stations within a five minute walk of the Brisbane Convention and Exhibition Centre. South Bank Station accessed from Tribune Street and South Brisbane Railway Station adjacent to the Convention Centre in Grey Street.</p> <p>AIRTRAIN Airtrain - Catch the Airtrain from South Brisbane station to Brisbane’s international and domestic airports. Tickets are available for this service from the Client and Visitors Services Centre located in the Main Foyer.</p> <p>TAXI A dedicated taxi rank is located at the main entrance of the Brisbane Convention and Exhibition Centre on the Corner of Merivale and Glenelg Streets. Taxis are also accessible in other locations in the South Bank precinct including the two hotels – Rydges and Mantra.</p> <p>CITY CAT The City Cat terminal is located outside the riverside restaurants on the Clem Jones Promenade. City Cats run daily from 5.30am-10.30pm.</p>																
PARKING	<p>The Centre provides undercover parking for 1500 vehicles, with direct lift access to the Centre's Convention and Exhibition facilities.
